REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT B/A KEITH D. HILL FEBRUARY 2021

Below is my report for the month of FEBRUARY 2021 presented to the Executive Board for the Zoom Executive Board Meeting on March 8, 2021.

COVID VACCINATION:

January 24, 2021 was the first day transit operators could register to be vaccinated. Both Locals (241 & 308) reached out to CTA President Dorval Carter and Mayor Lori Lightfoot to express how difficult it was for us to register to get the opportunity to be vaccinated. After several meetings and with both Locals and the CTA pushing, I'm glad to say vaccination for all CTA workers will be available at 5 locations on CTA properties. Also, I would like to give a big thanks to President Dorval Carter for his assistance on this project.

- PACE Brothers and Sisters, we are still trying to get PACE management to secure their own vaccinations for its workers. PACE will be able to go to a few sites that either have set aside vaccination just for them or with a group within the 1(b) group, please watch out for the notices at PACE.

Moderna:

- Number of shots: 2 shots, one month (28 days) apart.
How it's given: Shot in the muscle of the upper arm.

Does not contain: Eggs, Preservatives or Latex.

Common Side Effects:

- In the arm where you got the shot: Pain, Redness and maybe Swelling. Throughout the rest of your body: tiredness, headaches, muscle pains, chills, fevers and nausea. These side effects usually start within a day or two of getting the vaccine. Side effects might affect your ability to do daily activities, but they should go away in a few days.

Summary of Safety Data:

- In clinical trials, reactogenicity symptoms (side effects that happen within 7 days of getting vaccinated) were common but were mostly mild to moderate. Side effects (such as fevers, chills, tiredness, and headaches) throughout the body were more common after the second dose of the vaccine. Most side effects were mild to moderate, however, a small number of people had severe side effects that affected their ability to do daily activities.
- Pace and those who would like Johnson and Johnson shot, the **O'Hare Point of Dispensing (POD)** at the Hilton Chicago O'Hare Airport Hotel will not be open to the general public. The site will start dispensing shots to public transit employees on Friday, March 5, 2021, and will operate from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesdays through Saturdays. Appointments will be required for all vaccinations and walk-ins will not be allowed. There will be no cost to recipients and insurance will not be required.
- Vaccines at the **O'Hare POD** will be limited to airport employees and other public transit workers with agencies such as the **CTA, Metra and PACE**, as well as taxi and ride share drivers. Approximately 500 individuals will be vaccinated each day. The site will first prioritize vaccinating first responders and security personnel, followed by public transit personnel who have direct contact with passengers, including flight crews, bus drivers and taxi drivers. Once those groups have been immunized, appointments will open up for pilots and mechanics, followed by all other airport employees. Remember it is your choice to get vaccinated **no one will be forced or disciplined for not participating**. Please do your research or talk with your doctor and make the right choice for you and your family.

PRE-ARB and EXPEDITED ARBITRATION:

- Local 241 will be restarting Pre-Arb and Expedited in the month of March. This process has been used to resolve grievances and return our Brothers and Sisters back to work.
- We had four (4) Labor Board charges dismissed for lack of merit.
- We also had a court case finalized that brought a brother back to work in a different position. This court case would have been very hard on this membership and strengthening the CTA's zero tolerance policy. Please remember that using your cellphone while driving the bus is against the law and CTA rules.

CONTRACT TALKS:

- Both Locals are ready to restart negotiations with the CTA. This administration believes that this membership deserves to be rewarded for the dedication we've displayed, especially over the last year. Both Locals have had a few meetings and made a few adjustments and we are looking forward to our dates coming up.

CONTRACT TALKS (cont.):

- PACE West, we are sending our letter to open negotiations soon to try to get them to the table before the current contract expires. We are ready to bring this fight to PACE and bring some dignity to a few areas. Pension remains the focus of the Local and the PACE members. Look out for the contract proposals and let your voice be heard.

CONTROL CENTER:

- We had a meeting with the Control Center General Manager and the Senior Manager this month. In this meeting, we expressed concerns and confusion. When an operator calls the Control Center, they are looking for assistance but are often met with hostility from a controller. The Union believes the controllers often place the operator in an unsafe or hostile work environment. The Union is aggressively looking for solutions from the CTA and a change in behavior from the controllers. We have a follow up meeting to push them to respond to the operators better.
- If a member has a problem with a controller please get the controllers number and put it in writing for the Local to address this. We as operators deal with enough stress driving to not get help when we call someone to help us. Please work with the Local as we address this problem.

GENERAL OFFICE:

Executive Board Member Paul Tolson joined me in two (2) Labor Management meetings this month for General Office.

- We met with the laborers in the South Shops where they expressed concerns with their work assignments and disparity in treatment. We talked with management who agreed to address and fix their concerns.
- We also met with management at 901. Our warehouse workers have been working without a pick because of the lack of hiring. This brought a concern to Local 241 seeing that they have been trying to hire for over a year and half. Leaving this meeting it brought more concerns about CTA's hiring process and how they are reducing the opportunity for members to move around and by changing the test or making it difficult for members to pass, open the door for them to bring in outside people first. So, this is being addressed and we will keep all updated on the progress.

STATION CLERKS:

Executive Board Member William Belue and myself had several meetings to address work assigned for the extra board and overtime.

- We have come to an agreement on how work will be assigned on the extra board. The highest paying jobs will go in seniority order. We are still talking about overtime and have not come to a conclusion on this.
- We have a few more things we are trying to schedule to help the clerks get some of the work back that was taken from them over the years.

CHICAGO FEDERATION of LABOR (CFL):

April of 2017 when this administration took office, Local 241 had no seat on the CFL Executive Board. Local 241 had lost this seat going back to November of 2012.

- Well, I stand proud of this administration as we have accomplished another one of the goals set forth when we took office.

From the CFL Executive Board Meeting Minutes-Monday, March 1, 2021

BOARD ACTION: Motion to appoint Keith Hill (ATU Local 241) to the CFL Executive Board member made by Mack Julion (NALC Branch 11) and second by John Spiros, Jr. (Painters District Council 14). Motion passed unanimously.

Brother Hill thanked the CFL Executive Board for the opportunity to serve and stated he is excited to get to work on behalf of the working people of Cook County.

- Local 241 has now regained their seat back on the CFL Executive Board. Every quarter the Union pays the CFL \$10,000 plus in per capita, but had no voice. How do we move this city but had no voice in the city's labor force? This was one of many seats we had given up dating back to 2012 until this administration started to regaining them back.
- We have also recovered the meeting and activity with the AFL (American Federation of Labor), although we have never held a seat, we were a strong participant in the AFL which was also absent from since 2012 and we've recovered this year.

I would like to say thank you to this membership for trusting me and this administration because we have regained our Local's presence with every major seat, we had lost going back to 2012. Pension Chair 2019, RHCT Chair 2019, CFL 2021.



REPORT OF THE FINANCIAL & RECORDING SECRETARY – TREASURER

A.T.U. Local 241 Interim Election and Nominations

Due to vacancies in Local 241, we will be holding an Interim Election on April 13th, 2021. This election will be conducted in accordance with the ATU Constitution and General Laws and the Local 241 Bylaws. The first mailing has already been sent to the printer for mailing. Our warden was dispatched on March 3, 2021 to make the proper postings.

A.T.U. Local 241 Audit

All bills are paid and current. Our Per Capita Tax is paid and Local 241 is in “good standing with the ATU International. The six – month audit and the LM2 has been completed for the year of 2020. As always, I will keep the Membership informed of the results once they are released.

Open Grievances

Open grievances for the month ending February 2021 are 1992.

Pension

The Board of Trustees meeting was held on February 25, 2021. The Local 241 Retirement plan payments have been paid and is current. As a result of the Local 241 Retirement Plan reaching 100% funding in 2020, the 2020 Minimum Required Contribution that would have been due on 1/15/2021 has been covered by prior payments. Therefore, no further contributions are due for the year 2020. In Addition, because the plan is over 100% funded for 2020, No quarterly contributions will be required for 2021. The next contribution due will be 9/15/2022 (pending the results of the 2021 Valuation).

Contract Negotiations

After a pause, due to the COVID – 19 Pandemic, CTA and Locals 241/308 have restarted contract talks. On February 3, 2020 the Officers of both Local 241/308 sat down for a pre-contract negotiations meeting. We have an upcoming contract negotiations meeting scheduled with CTA and both Locals. President Hill has outlined in his reports what our goals are moving forward. Local 241 will continue to keep the Membership updated on the progress of contract negotiations and any other pertinent information that the Members should know. In order to stay updated, continue to be on the lookout for our reports and read them as soon as they are sent out to the properties monthly and or contact the Local office.

Member Payroll and Reed Group Issues

I continue to be presented with Payroll and Reed Group Issues. I want to continue to remind our Members that Documentation must accompany your paperwork. As many of you know, resolving payroll and Reed Group problems has become an everyday day.

I have been receiving an influx of calls about W2's and check stubs. Please be aware that W2's and pay slips are on the CTA Portal. The CTA portal is available on and off property. If further assistance is needed the member can send an email to surfacepay@transitchicago.com. You will receive a verification questionnaire to complete regarding your issue.

******* Remember *******

- Whenever a problem arises with payroll or the Reed Group, please notify your Union Representative first. This is always our first line of defense as a Union
- Make sure you keep and provide all the documentation associated with the problem.
- If it becomes necessary to visit me, please make sure that you schedule an appointment. I want to make sure that I can continue accommodate the Members in an orderly fashion during these extraordinary times.

Member Arrears

As a continued reminder, if you have been off for an extended period of time, it is possible that you may be in the arrears on your union dues. Please continue to check the Union Board for arrears notices letting you know when we will begin the collection of arrears.

COVID – 19 Vaccinations and Garage Visit



Hi Toi,

The 2020 Actuarial Valuation Report is currently in review, but I wanted to reach out and let you know that due to the Plan's 2020 AFTAP reaching 100%, the 2020 Plan Year contributions that have already been paid have satisfied the 2020 Minimum Required Contribution. The contribution that would be due 1/15/2021 has been covered by prior payments, so no further contributions are due for 2020.

In addition, because the Plan is above 100% funding for 2020, quarterly contributions will not be required for the 2021 plan year. The next contribution due will be 9/15/2022 pending the results of the 2021 Valuation.

CTA management is getting out of control, they feel that they can talk to you (the Union Officers) any type of way. Respect is given when it is received.


PENSION

COVID-19 TESTING

Use the QR code that I provided on this report to make your COVID-19 Vaccine appointment, CTA is providing the employees with the Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine. The Vaccination Sites will move to different locations and it is FREE TO ALL EMPLOYEES. If you do not know how to use the QR feature follow these simple steps, first pull out your smart phone, then go to the camera function and just point to this paper and it will read the code then follow the instructions from your phone.

Facts to Remember.

- It is Available to all Employees.
- CTA Employee ID badge is needed to receive the Vaccine.
- NO INSURANCE COVERAGE IS REQUIRED
- Once you set your first appointment the system automatically set your second appointment.
- This action must be done on your own time, if you schedule your appointment during your lunch hour, keep in mind that you may experience some side effects, that is why this should be done after work or on your day off.
- THIS IS NOT MANDATORY



Bus Servicer Apprentices you do not need to have insurance coverage in order to receive the vaccination, you should alert your manager the day you will be going to receive the vaccine so they know maybe it will be a situation you can not come to work that night, and if it is a situation you should also alert Marqueal Williams (312)888-6364. Just because you received the vaccination you are still required to maintain social distance around the garage, we are so close to finally getting this virus in control and now is not the time to put our guard down and relax.

Discipline Hearings

As I reported last month, I cannot express this enough, if you need Union Representation you MUST call the representative of your location, in the Maintenance Department we do not have set Discipline Days, and Management do not give the Union Reps a call to let us know that you are being disciplined.

You and ONLY YOU are responsible to call the union, you have 24 hours to receive union representation from the time the manager gives you the referral. You should call your Union Representative as soon as possible if you do not know the Union Rep at your location call Marqueal Williams (312)888-6364.

General Clean Bus Servicer Apprentices

Starting 3/3/2021 Bus Servicer Apprentices will be doing General Clean in this order, no more than (2) Two Buses a night, if you do a 60 ft bus you may be asked to split a 40 ft. bus. You do not have to clean no exterior of any bus. You may be asked to work on (2) two 40 ft. bus, this is a normal day.

Bus Servicers Apprentice Mopping Program

The Maintenance Department Management is convinced that the Bus Servicers Apprentice could do any job that is on the General Clean Job Description sheet, the company believes that if wiping dash boards is on that list then, they can go and wipe dash boards throughout the garage, also because mopping floors is on the general clean description sheet, Management started a mopping program using the Bus Apprentices only, Myself along with President Keith Hill put a stop to this action.

The Company is clearly trying to replace the Bus Servicer with the Apprentice Program, we must monitor all actions with our Bus Servicer because the question was asked "HOW LONG THEY BEEN MOPPING" the company attorney was fishing trying to establish a past practice case. We understand that Mopping is regular work that a Bus Servicer do in the wintertime for overtime. If you see a Bus Service Apprentice doing Regular Mopping only and no general clean of buses, you should call your union reps or Marqueal Williams (312)888-6364.

Garage Pick

We are forced with fighting for our jobs on the Garage Pick sheets, when you see the pick you will see missing positions, (2) from 77th, (2) from 74th, (2) from Kedzie, (2) from Chicago Ave, (2) from North Park a total of 10 position have be DE-budgeted form the Maintenance Department. I am being told that this happened back in 2018, but in 2018 we were in contract negotiations and during negotiations I ask Donald Bonds "I was told that the maintenance department will be losing positions", I was told by Donald Bonds "No Position will be lost from the Maintenance Department".

Now during the System Pick we were told about the DE-budgeting of the Maintenance Positions, I definitely would say that this is a breach of contract, I definitely would say this is an attack on the maintenance department, During the System CTA Maintenance Management tried to remove Servicers Spots from the Pick, but because of the Bus Servicer Apprentice Agreement it clearly states that if CTA remove one Service Position, the Bus Apprentices Program would End, CTA quickly placed the Servicers Position back on the pick.


