



REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT B/A KEITH D. HILL JULY 2021

Below is my report for the month of July 2021, presented to the Executive Board on July 30, 2021 and the Members on August 3, 2021 during the Mass Membership Meeting.

CONTRACT TALKS:

- ➤ <u>CTA Contract</u> talks are under way and moving at this point. The CTA did present the Union with some gut-wrenching proposals. Local 241 Officers and members will keep the mindset, that this membership has nothing to give and nothing to lose. As members, we work too hard for the things we have and will take a stand to keep them.
- After a few meetings with the CTA and out of our 25 Local proposals, only two have been rejected at this point. Negotiations will be going on during the month of August with over 28 dates scheduled in the month. We will keep the members updated on all points as they come about. Be looking for Rap Sessions at your location as well.
- First Transit We have taken in over 20 proposals from the members and have placed them in order of importance as the members request and will be passing them out soon at your location.
- ➤ EQT Infrastructure has entered into an agreement to acquire First Transit, Inc. from FirstGroup plc. The transaction is expected to be completed later this summer. As such, EQT Infrastructure will replace FirstGroup plc as the corporate owner of First Transit, Inc. Despite the change in corporate ownership, First Transit, Inc. will remain the employer of the employees covered by the collective bargaining agreement(s) currently in place with your Local 241. As such, First Transit, Inc. remains bound by the collective bargaining agreement and our location operations teams will continue to work with Local 241 Union representatives as they have done in the past.
- We have Five dates in the month of August for negotiations and we will work hard to bring the members of First Transit a good contract.

CONTRACT TALKS (Cont.):

- PACE West We have started to collect contract proposals from the members, we will put them in order of importance as the members wish or see them. We also will be asking a few members to join us on the negotiating team, so please look out for the letter and join us, this is your chance to represent yourself and brothers and sisters of PACE.
- We are also hoping things in the state remain open so we can get the talks underway so please keep an eye open on the status of the state because this will affect the start and progression of the negotiating.
- PACE North Shore We have sent a letter to start contract talks. PACE has excepted and agreed to start the process. Members, please take the time to fill out the proposal forms and get it in to Local 241. Some have already started emailing and mailing their proposals in to the Local and we thank you. We will put them in order of importance according to the members wishes and post them at your locations. Local 241 is also looking for a few members to sit on the negotiating team as well.
- We are in the process of working with PACE to hold an election, if the state remains open in the upcoming weeks. So please look for all posting and stay Intune.

As we work on four different contracts all members remember this and post it on FACEBOOK, remind other Brothers and Sisters this *LOCAL 241 DON'T HAVE ANYTHING TO GIVE UP OR NOTHING TO LOSE!!!!!!!* ONE241

SECURITY MEETING:

- > Security remains one of the most important issues of this administration. The safety of all members at CTA, PACE and First Transit are top on the list of this administration.
- CTA had a meeting to address the concerns with both Local 241 and 308. In this meeting you had the head of CTA security and Commander Cline from the CPD. In this meeting we talked about the rising problems we are faced with on the bus and the lack of presence and response time to help us. The CTA shared the areas they deem to be hot spots or trouble spots in the system, I thanked them for showing concern and addressing this but the truth is the whole system is a hot spot. I expressed how it is no safe place in the system and we are always under attack from passengers. I did agree and shared concerns with some of the target locations and the CTA pointed out and agreed that more of a police presence and riding the bus will help but it needs to be on a consistent basis, not just one day.
- After the meeting I felt no better and asked the CTA to meet to address things we can do internally to help us.

SECURITY MEETING (cont.):

- > The Local is asking for some type of light on top of the bus that will blink or strobe fast to let any police know we need help on the bus as they are driving by. I brought up a few ideas for the silent alarm but will wait until they implement their new system to push them.
- Also, as an administration, we will not stop pushing our legislation in Springfield to have our own police department, we can operate the same way Metra police operate and do a better job. We will need a big push from the members to help with this in Springfield.
- Watch Congress, it's a bill called the <u>Transit Workers and Pedestrian Protection Act</u>, this bill will make CTA form a committee with the Union to protect us while we work, if they do not, they can lose federal funding. We are hoping this bill passes before the summer session ends, I'll keep all posted as things develop.

UNIFORM STORE:

- > Starting August 2021, CTA uniform contract will be switching from Galls to Silk Screen Express. Important Dates for the Transition from Galls to Silk Screen Express:
 - August 6, 2021, Friday Last day that Galls stores will serve CTA employees. •
 Last day for CTA employees to pick up merchandise purchased from Galls.
 - All unclaimed merchandise must be picked up from the appropriate Galls store by Friday, August 6, 2021.
 - Saturday, August 7, 2021, through Sunday, August 15, 2021 No uniforms will be available for purchase (Separate arrangements will be made for Union-related reinstatements.)
 - Monday, August 16, 2021 Employees can begin purchasing uniform items from the Silk Screen Express stores.
- There are no changes to the current CTA uniform or work clothing item requirements; employees will continue to wear their current uniform/work clothing items, which will be available for purchase or order from Silk Screen Express.
- ➤ Employee uniform allotment will not be affected by this transition. Employee voucher balances will carry over from Galls to Silk Screen Express. The Silk Screen Express uniform website will be available at a later date.
- Until the Silk Screen Express website is available, all purchases must be made in person at a Silk Screen Express store. Employees must continue to show their employee identification card and a government issued photo identification card to place an in-store order:

INTERNATIONAL TRAINING:

- Executive Board Members Gatewood, Cain and Montgomery and myself attended ATU Race and Labor Training. The Race and Labor Training Program examined the history of racism and racism in the labor movement, including racial oppression and discrimination at the workplace. The instructor covered the different manifestations of racism and how racism can be used to strategically weaken workers and their Unions.
- The program offered various strategies and tactics that can be used to interrupt oppressive moments. The training was held by Bianca Cunningham and was very interesting. It brought attention to things that we overlook every day, but are very old tactics to keep oppression going.
- The Executive Board along with other Officers will be attending classes in the future to make us stronger and better as we serve the members.

TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE LABOR COMMITTEE:

- I also sit on the Transportation Infrastructure Labor Committee for the CFL (Chicago Federation of Labor). In this committee we talk about the safety of the members, better shields and the big wave of zero emission buses that might be headed CTA's way.
- We also discussed PACE and the safety and access to get to certain routes and places. I explained that transit as a whole has many places that are hard for people to access them whether CTA or PACE.
- This is an issue that has been addressed in the stimulus package that both agencies received and in the infrastructure bill and if the agencies go by the bill this will be addressed whether you are in the suburbs or the city.

SUPERVISORS' MEETING:

- ➤ I had the pleasure of attending a supervisors south region meeting at 77th. The supervisors in my eye are often not commended for the work they do to help keep the city going. I just want to say, I THANK YOU.
- In this meeting they discussed a few things and aired out a few concerns. On the most part, it was a great honor to sit with them because I normally talk to them on the fly. I will be attending all other region meetings to hear the concerns of the other groups and help them work on it as well. ONCE AGAIN, I THANK YOU FOR THE HARD WORK YOU DO.

EXPEDITED AND PRE-ARBITRATION:

- Local 241 and the CTA held Expedited Arbitration hearings this month discussing over (60) grievances, winning (40) in some fashion & losing (20) by way of the arbitrators ruling.
- ➤ We are trying to obtain a date for Pre-Arbitration in the month of August although the contract remains our focal point, we are working to get a date to help our Brothers and Sisters return to work.
- > We also had four (4) more cases dismissed from the department of labor ruling in the favor of the Union.

U.S. TRANSPORTATION SECRETARY BUTTIGIEG:

➤ I had the opportunity to sit with Secretary Buttigieg, Mayor Lightfoot, U.S. Senator Duckworth and U.S. Senator Durbin to discuss the need for transit and how to better transit in the years to come. This was my second time meeting Secretary Buttigieg. I met him during the lowa Caucus, I thought he was sharp and on point with a lot of his views now meeting him as the Secretary of Transportation and listening to his views and goals, I'm happy and very optimistic on how things will grow and get better for us as workers. It was really nice to hear elected officials supporting the working class.

FAMILY OF JOBS:

- I would like to commend FRST Toi Bowers and Board Member Tolson and Steward Hill for working on the jobs in General Office.
- We have been addressing the loss of bodies and the disappearance of jobs in General Office. Reprographics had an opening that CTA was not trying to fill, and after a meeting with Toi and myself, we can gladly say the CTA will be filling the job and working with Local 241 to fill the other open jobs.

BANK OF AMERICA PAYROLL DEBIT CARD:

➤ Due to the very high volume of fraud cases with Bank of America, the "Payroll Debit Card" will be cancelled and end soon. Therefore, those members who have the "Bank of America Payroll Debit Card" that was issued through CTA, will soon have to replace this method with another mechanism to receive their payroll. If you need any assistance, please call the Union office.

DISCIPLINE:

- ➤ Brothers and Sisters please stop allowing CTA to mark up your record. Over the last month I have done a few hearings and handled discipline in all locations. When they call you in the office on a complaint, please stop the interview and request the Union.
- We are having a few issues with payroll and seven-day sick claim, please reach out to the Union.
- ➤ Brothers and Sisters please record everyone that board your bus, that's PACE and CTA. Ridership will play a role in the future and it will help or hurt us.
- > We as operators must do a better job of looking out for each other and working better together, we are all we got on the street.
- For the next month, let's work on being one band one sound one group as we are each other's keeper. Let's be safe and call the Union if you need help.

<u>Assistant Business Agent – Maintenance August 2021 Report</u> By Marqueal L. Williams

Pension and RHCT

I (Marqueal Williams) am an Assistant Trustee to the Chicago Transit Pension and Retiree Health Care Trust. As of July 22, 2021, the Pension Plan funding is \$2,049,652,600.06, \$18 million in cash, the Multiplier Factor for the retirement plan is .0215%. The Pension contribution per paycheck is 13.324%, and the Chicago Transit Authority contribution is 20.647%. The Pension Plan has hit remarkable numbers over 2 Billion Dollars, not only the Pension Plan also the Retiree Health Care Trust Plan funding is \$1,117,883,622.42, \$3,241,463.91 in cash, over 1 Billion Dollars remarkable, the RHCT contribution per paycheck is 3%, President Keith Hill and this current administration fought hard to have the contribution dropped to 1% of your paycheck starting in January of 2022, only 4 more months of paying the 3%, to check every penny that you contribute into the Health Care Trust from you paycheck go to www.groupadminstrators.com.

Safety

Due to the high number of COVID in the Maintenance Department and several deaths we may have forgot about but must not let it go in vain, we must still demand from The Chicago Transit Authority a Clean and Virus Free workplace, also continuous PPE.

Summer has finally arrived, and the City of Chicago has fully opened back up be aware this pandemic has not left, this pandemic has no plans of departure, when we just received vaccination for COVID-19, Now we are being told that a Delta Variant is transmissible, able to be passed on from one person or organism to another. We must not let our guards down, lets make sure we are still waring our masks, keeping our social distances if possible, washing our hands.

Note: If Management do not have the PPE your requesting, contact your Union Representative we will make sure that PPE is distributed upon request.

Discipline Hearings

When I go on the property to do fire drills I find myself doing more discipline because you failed to call your Union Rep, I'm receiving more phone call because Manager is proceeding with the discipline because YOU failed to call you Union Rep to advise him that YOU received a Referral, if you need Union Representation you MUST call the representative of your location, in the Maintenance Department we do not have set Discipline Days, and Management do not give the Union Reps a "heads up" that you are being disciplined. You have 24 hours to receive union representation from the time the manager gives you the referral. You should call your Union Representative as soon as possible

Exchange a Schedule Day Off Request

The Union and CTA is at talks about creating an extra board in the maintenance department to allow a maintenance employees to switch days off. We currently have a process that does this, it is called Exchange A Schedule Day Off Request, this form is available upon request, if you found someone

who is off on the day you need off you can switch off days, you only get some many VRD'S, so if you need a day use this process and save your VRD'S for emergencies or when you just need a Me-Day.

72 Hours Notice to Use VRD'S

It has been a long and hard fight to get the Maintenance Department VRD's days situated, in this Union and any other Union you need leaders with longevity to know what we gave up and what we gave into to achieve our goal.

History Lesson; In April of 2015 the Maintenance Department was given a new set of Vacation Pick Quotas, and this was to be done by Shift and not Seniority, the Union was in a fight with this in 2015 we were blessed and achieve our goal and held on to what we had, also the same fight in 2016, 2017, and in 2018 we attached our Vacation Pick Quotas in the CBA attached to the Bus Servicer Apprentice Agreement allowing it to be contractual, now CTA is crying about MANPOWER.

Manpower is and is not a Union Issue. Manpower is a Union issue when you don't have enough employees to do a job and you're relying on our Members to do the work of (2) two or more people. That's when Manpower becomes a UNION ISSUE.

Manpower is not a Union Issue when you must have an emergency pick, when you must cancel vacations, when you cancel the use of VRD'S, that's when Manpower is not a Union Issue, because Management do not have the right to cancel Vacations and VRD'S. I you have a situation with Management contact you Garage Steward.

Now we come to the part when Management has the right to deny your VRD Request, by Union Contract you have 72 hours to make the request if the day is open, not (3) three days.
